You <u>may</u> qualify for one or both refunds from the State of Minnesota based on your 2025 Property Taxes. If you owned and occupied this property as your homestead on January 2, 2025, you may qualify for one or both of the following homestead credit refunds:

1. Property Tax Refund - If your taxes exceed certain income-based thresholds, and your total household income is less than \$139,320.

- Special Property Tax Refund If you also owned and occupied this property as your homestead 2. on January 2, 2024, and **both** of the following are true:
 - The net property tax on your homestead increased by more than 12% from 2024 to 2025.
 - The increase was at least \$100, not due to improvements on the property.

Penalty For Late Payment Of Property Tax

If you pay your first half or second half property tax after the due dates, a penalty will be added to your tax. The later you pay, the greater the penalty you must pay. The table below shows the penalty amounts added to your tax if your property taxes are not paid before the date shown.
